Beauty Basics From Daytime's Stars And Experts

Every show has makeup artists on call, ready to powder noses at the slightest sign of shine. But what do actresses do when they're on their own? Artist-to-the-stars Duane Sevelin has developed a following among the soap set with his Sevelin Survival Kit, which includes dual action foundation/powder, three eye shadows, mascara, lip conditioner, lip liner and three brushes. You also get a mud mask and moisturizer for good measure. "Makeup should be really simple," believes Sevelin. "People are tired of things in their makeup kit that they don't use." (If you don't know anything about applying makeup, an instruction kit and a face chart come with every kit.)

ONE LIFE TO LIVE's Krista Tesreau (Tina) sings Sevelin's praises. "I asked Duane almost a year in advance if he would do my makeup for the Emmys this May," laughs Tesreau. "He really has the talent." Tesreau's co-star, Crystal Chappell (Maggie), appreciates the Survival Kit. "My two favorite things are the blush and the lip liner," she says. Even OLTL's Kassie Wesley (Blair), who admits she steers clear of heavy makeup when she's off the set, likes the moisturizing stick. "I like to have lip balm," says Kassie Wesley (Blair). "I probably have every brand out there."
